2. Monitoring and Evaluation Procedures

SKS has an extensive setup for monitoring and evaluating its programs. For this purpose, a dedicated Monitoring, Evaluation and Research section is in place where dedicated staff monitors the overall activities of the organization. The section is led by M&E Coordinator. The activities are also monitored by the Executive Director and by the Programme Manager.

SKS develops project specific monitoring and evaluation plans and tools for each donor funded project. We have a strong data management and quality assurance system. SKS has documentation capacity and documents processes and M&E findings in order to facilitate organizational learning.

Also, SKS uses its M&E findings not only for accountability to the donors, but also for organizational learning and program improvement.

3. Financial and Operational Capacity

Financial discipline is observed in a computerized manner using dual system of latest software options (Quick Books). SKS has a very elaborate Financial Policies and Procedures Manual, developed through a very exhaustive and participatory process involving the target communities, management, field staff, MC, and professional experts. This makes the SKS management rule bound, extremely predictable, transparent and accountable.

Regular Annual Financial Audit is conducted by internationally recognized chartered accountants both for accountability and ensuring transparency. Annual audit reports are attached.

4. Networking and coordination

Saiban Kisan Society-SKS is a member of PHF and NHN in Punjab Province and also signed MOUs with social welfare department, RESCUE1122, Emergency Response Team-ERT and contributed in development of district contingency planning by departments on the behalf of PDMA.
